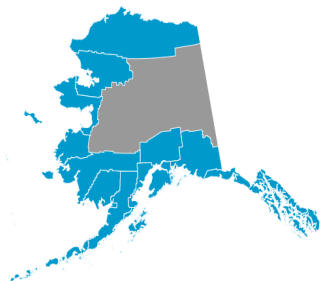


Great Lakes coastal watershed counties are home to the third largest number of U.S. residents when compared to other coasts.

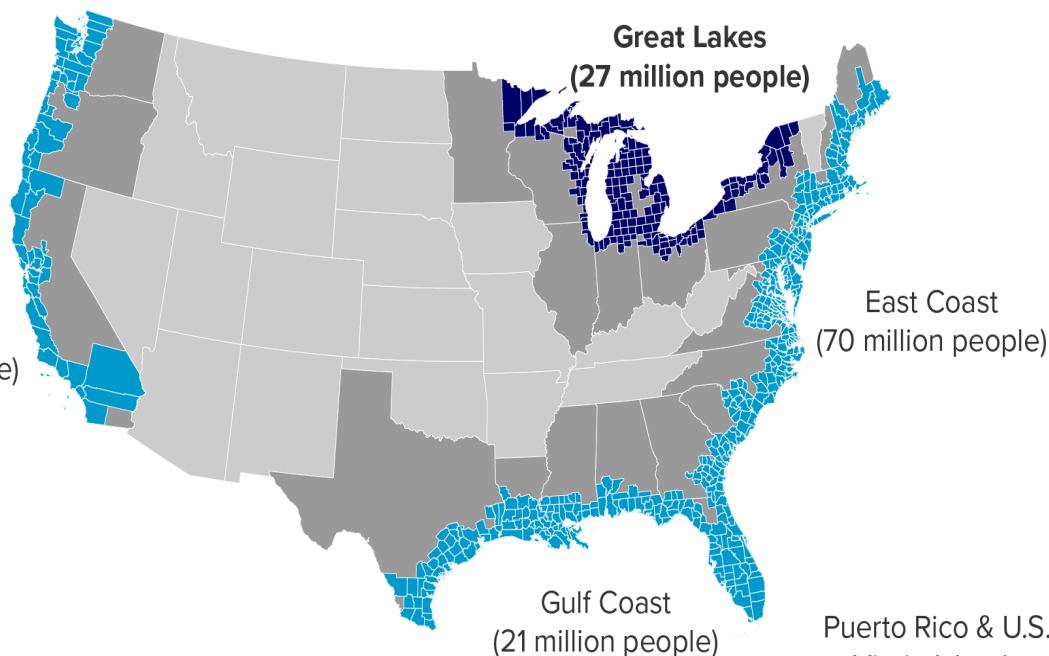
Alaska (1 million people)
